The Street Art Festival at Surface celebrates and supports Nottingham's thriving alternative art scene by showcasing some of today's best local, national, and international street art.

Up to six pieces can be submitted per person and all work will be hung salon-style, packed from floor to ceiling. All submissions will be displayed as long as you can get them through the door.

Submissions can be delivered to the gallery on the delivery dates with a completed application form and small entry fee. Application packs can be downloaded from surfacegallery.org or paper copies can be picked up from the gallery during opening hours.

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

- All works will be included in the exhibition as long as they comply with the rest of this list:
- Up to six works may be submitted at a cost of £5 per work, or £20 for 6 works
- The entry fee must be paid in cash upon delivery of the works to Surface Gallery. Alternatively, if work is delivered by courier the entry fee can be paid by bank transfer
- All works must be delivered to Surface during the times listed on this application form
- All relevant fixings must be attached to the work ready for hanging. This might include mirror plates, hanging straps or D-rings. If your work is unframed you must provide an alternative to secure the work to the wall, e.g. bulldog clips
- Video or other electronic submissions must provide their own AV equipment
- If you'd like to make work directly on the walls or in the gallery space, please email us ahead of the submission dates to let us know
- Your name and the title of the work must be written clearly on the back of the entry
- We cannot accept online or email submissions



If you need to post your work to us, make sure it arrives no later than Saturday 9th July. If you want your work returned if it's not for sale or doesn't sell, please also send us a cheque to cover return postage and packing costs.

International submissions can pay entry fees via Paypal to submissions@surfacegallery.org. All fees must be paid in Pound Sterling ( $\pounds$ ).

#### **COLLECTING YOUR WORK**

We will be open on the following days ONLY for collection of works:

- Sunday 3rd September 12.00 16.00
- Monday 4th September 12.00 16.00

If it is not possible to collect your work on the above dates, please ensure that you contact Surface and arrange another date to collect your work. Any work left at the gallery after these days without explanation will be deemed abandoned and will be disposed of as Surface sees fit.

#### **SELLING YOUR WORK**

You are welcome to sell your work. Surface receives 20% commission on each work sold during the exhibition, from the price stated on your application form. Please take this into consideration when pricing your work. If you don't want to sell your work, please write 'NOT FOR SALE' clearly on the application form and on the back of each relevant work.

#### INSURANCE

We'll take every precaution to safeguard all submitted work, but we are unable to provide insurance for artworks. We advise artists to insure their own work against loss or damage. Surface will not be held responsible for any works damaged during transit to and from the gallery or while the artwork is under the gallery's care.
